



## History Pocket

### Before Co-op Meeting:

1. Review History Overview (Handbook) to understand philosophy and ideas behind this week's lesson.
2. Read:
  - Aesop's Fables - Kindness (DL)*
3. Review *Ancient Civilizations* History Pocket 4 "Ancient Greece"
4. Gather and print materials needed for History Pocket 4: "Cut and Paste," "Fact Sheet," and "Student Booklet".

### Lesson Goals:

1. To learn about the culture of Ancient Greece.
2. To begin to consider the significance of Greece's contributions to Western Culture.

### At Co-op Preparation:

- Gather all materials and place them neatly to the side.
- Have paper towels and cleaning spray ready for clean-up time.

### In Class:

1. Ask students what they know about the Ancient Greeks.
2. Read the "Fact Sheet: Ancient Greece" aloud.
3. Ask the students to list the important contributions of the Greeks.
4. Write down what the students say on a whiteboard, chalkboard, or large piece of paper for everyone to see.
5. Pass out Pocket materials and help students start the activities.
6. Instruct students to finish their Pocket at home.

### Clean-up:

- Place the students' crafts to the side to dry on a table. These can be picked up by students at the end of the day.
- Use paper towels and cleaning spray to clean the tables if needed.
- Use paper towels and cleaning spray to wash any glue from the tables.
