



Paper Puppets

- ❖ Students will create paper puppets of a knight and princess this week. These may be used in puppet shows throughout the week to re-enact the stories they read.

Before Co-op Meeting:

1. Review History Overview (Handbook) to understand philosophy and ideas behind this week's lesson.

Lesson Goals:

1. To complete a hands-on craft to enrich the student's play acting during the week.

At Co-op Preparation:

- Have all materials laid out and ready before the lesson.
- If necessary have paper towels and cleaning spray ready for clean-up time.

In Class:

1. Explain to the students that they will make paper puppets of a knight and princess.
2. Pass out materials and help students assemble puppets.
 - Encourage students to use their puppets during the week to re-enact stories they hear or to create their own stories.

Clean-up:

- If necessary, use paper towels and cleaning spray to clean the tables if needed.
