



Instructions:

1. Have your student go on a rock hunt in the backyard to find a “favorite rock” and a handful of other rocks.
2. Help your student with the following steps:

STEP 1

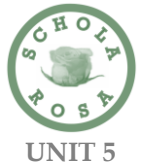
Draw a picture of your favorite rock. Try to make your drawing the same shape as your rock. Color your picture the same color as your rock.

My rock:

A large, empty rectangular box with a thin black border, intended for the student to draw their favorite rock.

STEP 2

How many paper clips fit around your rock? Draw your paper clip chain. You should draw the same number of paper clips that fit around your rock.



STEP 3

Now that you have measured your rock, compare your rock to the other rocks you collected. Are the other rocks lighter or heavier than your rock?

How many rocks in all?	How many are lighter?	How many are heavier?

STEP 4

Draw a picture of where you found your rocks!
